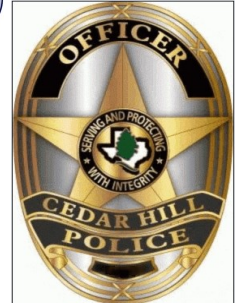

Significant Investigation

On 8/26/2021, officers responded to Americas Best Contacts and Glasses on a report of suspicious activity. Subjects in a black Chevy Silverado pickup truck were seen trying to enter other vehicles in the parking lot. This vehicle left before officers arrived but it was located and stopped a short distance away with five occupants.

An investigation revealed the vehicle had been stolen the previous day in DeSoto. Officers located video of the suspects attempting to enter several other vehicles in the Target parking lot.

One of the suspects was tied to a prior stolen vehicle offense through latent fingerprints that were recovered.
