Significant Investigation

On Saturday April 12, 2025 at approximately 1:40pm Cedar Hill Officers responded to the 900 block of Nikkie Street in reference to a report of gun shots. Callers reported hearing four gun shots coming from behind the residence. Officers were unable to locate any physical evidence and left the scene. Approximately two hours later a resident called and stated their AC unit had been shot and the window of his vehicle was shattered. Officers began searching the area and found evidence indicating the rounds were shot from a house in the 900 block of Hidden Lakes Drive. Based on the severity of the offense and with the shots being fired from inside the location, the Special Response Team (SRT) unit responded. SRT negotiated with the suspect, but he refused to come out of the residence. The sole occupant eventually surrendered to officers without incident and was taken into custody for Deadly Conduct.
