

Make a Presentation Recognizing Meadowbrooke as 2010 City of Cedar Hill Most Improved Neighborhood Award Recipient

Nestled along Red Oak Creek in the southwest part of the city is the Meadowbrooke Neighborhood. Development of this community spanned two decades and it is now home to 224 families. The Meadowbrooke Neighborhood Watch, founded in 2008, though still in its infancy, has developed an impressive network of homeowners and continues to reach out to their neighborhood and the community through regular meetings, special events and projects. And when bad weather postponed their National Night Out plans, they regrouped and hosted a spectacular event the following weekend with the largest attendance of any local event.

The neighborhood has a dedicated group of residents committed to making the community and their neighborhood a better place to live. The organization has grown in participation and activities and they are already making plans for National Night Out again this year.

The neighborhood ranked third in Yard of the Month awards from Keep Cedar Hill Beautiful and have become active participants in other citywide events.
